INFORMATION ON INDUCTIONS

Your scheduled induction date is _____.
You will be coming in as a same day admission.

Every effort will be made to admit elective inductions as scheduled. However, there is always the possibility that your admission to the Families Are First Unit may be delayed or cancelled if there are too many patients already in labor. In any event, those patients scheduled for elective inductions will be handled in order of medical necessity. Should a patient's scheduled induction be cancelled, she may have a non-stress test scheduled for assessing fetal well being and/or another induction date set.

Try to be well rested the night before admission. You may eat lightly prior to arrival (example: toast, cereal). Please call Families Are First at 585-3289 prior to leaving for the hospital to confirm bed availability. We will then expect you at the hospital Emergency Room/Admitting area at 6 AM or at 4 PM for evening inductions.

Once you arrive at Families Are First, you will be admitted to a birthing room where you will have a place to change, be placed on a monitor, and have your IV started. A pelvic exam will be done to assess your status prior to starting the inducing agent.
